MOST COMMON QUESTIONS ASKED BY NEW RESIDENTS

What ward do I live in? Go to the ward map at westfieldnj.gov/wardmap. The map includes a listing all streets and their respective ward. Where can I find voting information? The Town Clerk's office can assist you. Go to westfieldnj.gov/townclerk or call (908) 789-4030.

Who picks up household garbage? Because garbage collection is privatized, you may contract with a NJDEP licensed trash hauler of your choice. Please note that town ordinance requires pick up from the rear of the home and the health code requires at least two pick-ups per week.

How do I find out about commuter parking opportunities? Go to westfieldnj.gov/parking or call Parking Services at (908) 789-4044.

How do I get a dog/cat license? The Town Clerk's office issues dog and cat licenses. Go to westfieldnj.gov/townclerk and click on the paw icon, or call (908) 789-4030.

Where do I put my leaves? The Town picks up leaves curbside during leaf collection season only. Leaves may also be brought to the Conservation Center. Go to westfieldnj.gov/leafcollection for more information.

How do I join the pool? Go to westfieldnj.gov/pool and complete the "pool member interest form" online.

What do I do with my recyclables? The curbside recycling program operates on a biweekly basis by Grand Sanitation and services all residences in Town. Go to <u>westfieldnj.gov/recycling</u> for the schedule and a list of acceptable items. For missed pick-ups or other curbside pick-up issues, contact Grand Sanitation directly at (908) 222-1566. There is also many free recycling drop off opportunities at the Conservation Center. Go to <u>westfieldnj.gov/conservation</u> for more information.

Download the Westfield Connect app from your <u>Apple iOS</u> or <u>Google Android</u> device. Westfield Connect is a mobile app that allows you to easily report to the DPW non-emergency issues in town such as potholes and tree maintenance. This app uses GPS to recognize the location of your request and also allows you to upload pictures or videos to provide more detail. Once submitted, you'll be able to track the progress of your request as it is routed through the DPW for resolution.
